

DPW SPRING & SUMMER NEWSLETTER

The scheduled curbside brush pick up will begin the first week in May, and will be done zone by zone during the months of May and June. A map showing what zone you live in can be found on our website at www.villageofgouverneur.org. If you have tree limbs/brush to be picked up, please remember that it needs to be cut into manageable sized pieces (for example - no more than 6" in diameter and 6' long), anything too large will not be picked up. Please stack limbs in a pile with the butt ends facing the same direction. **LEAVES MUST BE BAGGED THIS YEAR.** During the months of July, August and September, brush pick up will be done as need and time permit.

If you wish to have your brush, etc. picked up sooner than your area is scheduled for, you can call the DPW office at 287-0110 and make an appointment to have a Dial-A-Truck left at your residence overnight. Once you have loaded the leaves, brush, ect. onto the truck, we will be back the following morning to take it away. If you schedule a Dial-A-Truck on a Thursday, the truck will be left with you for the weekend. There is no charge for the Dial-A-Truck service. Construction materials and garbage are not allowed on the Dial-A-Truck.

If you are having a tree cut down, you or your contractor can call the DPW and a truck will be left at your home overnight or over the weekend for the brush and tree to be piled into, please specify that the truck needed is for tree removal.

Beginning April 18, 2016, the DPW will be working their summer hours of Monday – Thursday from 6am until 4pm. If you have a water or sewer emergency outside of those hours, you can call the Village Police Department at 287-2121 and they will dispatch our on-call crew.

We are again accepting clean scrap metal at the Waste Water Treatment Facility, located on State Highway 58, just a couple of miles west of Gouverneur Hospital. Items allowed for collection are: large appliances (washers, stoves, etc.), metal shelving, metal posts, etc. Items not accepted are: tires, car batteries, air conditioners, refrigerators, and chemicals. The hours for drop off are Monday – Friday 7am – 3pm; and weekends by appointment by calling 287-2133. For any questions on acceptable items for drop off, please call the DPW office at 287-0110.
