Mayor McDougall called the Public Hearing to order.

Mayor McDougall read the following public notice:

PUBLIC NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that pursuant to Section 5-508 of the Village Law, a Tentative Budget showing the revenue and expenditures for the fiscal year of the Village of Gouverneur, New York, commencing June 1, 2018, was filed with the Clerk/Treasurer of said Village on March 5, 2018.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that a public hearing will be held by the Board of Trustees of said Village on the 3rd day of April 2018, at 6:00 p.m. in the Village Courtroom, 33 Clinton Street, Gouverneur, NY, for the purpose of considering and discussing such tentative budget. A copy of such Tentative Budget is available at the Village Clerk's Office, located at 33 Clinton Street, Gouverneur, NY where it may be inspected by any interested person during office hours, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Said Tentative Budget includes compensation for the Mayor of \$11,139.45 per annum, Deputy Mayor - \$8,911.56 per annum and for the Trustees of \$6,683.67 per annum.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that at said public hearing all persons are invited to attend and provide the Board with written and oral comments and ask questions concerning the Village's Tentative Budget.
